In terms of shape and profile, the Drillium is pretty much identical to the Easton FlatBoy, and both are the widest pedals on test. Obviously, the rounded edges on the FlatBoy offer better ground clearance, but if you've got huge feet the Drillium could be the pedal to go for.

Speedplay's 'built-in grease port' is just a screw in the pedal end cap and should not see too much action with twin cartridge bearings and a needle bearing in each pedal. Our biggest concern with the Drillium is mud-shedding — or lack of it.
